MARAVILLOSA MARCOS in good position early, lodged a four wide bid nearing the quarter pole, reached the front in the stretch then edged clear under mild urging. DANCE CHIEF between rivals and in a bit close on the clubhouse turn, raced five wide turning for home and finished willingly while second best. CATORCE DE LA FAMA (CHI) advanced between foes on the final turn and offered a mild stretch response. FOX IN THE HOUSE up close early three wide, bid for the lead on the final turn and battled for command then weakened in the drive. FAVORITE MEETING was six wide turning for home and offered a mild response. STORMIN STORY tracked early, chased on the final turn and tired in the drive. PENNY'S IMAGE set the pace inside and weakened in the drive. MATAMOR outrun early, raced off the inside turning for home and lacked a rally. FINALLY KRUISIN saved ground while well placed to the far turn and weakened. MILITARY DEPUTY never far back, drifted some into the lane raced five wide then tired. HE WHO LAUGHS LAST raced near the rail and lacked a rally. MR SHANE THE PAIN saved ground and lacked a bid. CARNERA was angled to the inside soon after the start then raced very rank along the rail passing the stands the initial time, moved back out into the clubhouse turn and lacked a bid. An objection by the trainer of FOX IN THE HOUSE against the winner for stretch interference was not allowed
