VALLEY STATION three wide on the turn, raced in the four path entering the stretch and finished gamely to prevail. SALADO TRIBE up close and three wide on the turn, reached the front in deep stretch but was outfinished by the top one. D'ORO MOMENTO challenged for the lead on the turn and raced between rivals turning for home, battled for command then yielded late. COME AWAY HOME raced near the rail on the turn and finished willingly while needing more. JUST SAY IT broke out bumping a rival, moved up inside and set the pace then weakened late. STATELY TOM raced just off the rail turning for home and lacked a rally. MISS ME YET bumped at the start, raced three wide passing the quarter pole and lacked the needed bid. JOHN JOHN'S GIFT was bumped then stumbled leaving the gate, saved ground and lacked a rally.
