**Footnotes**

BEAR FAMOUS TRIP was crowded at the start, raced mid pack, went six wide in the drive, closed willingly, assumed command past the sixteenth pole and drew off. MANSIONES settled off the pace, bid along the rail on the turn, dueled for the lead, assumed command briefly past the eighth pole, was no match for the winner and just lasted for second. EDGERIN J was unhurried early, angled out in the upper stretch, bid seven wide, finished well and was outnodded to just miss for place. PRIVATE ASSETS was crowded at the start, went six wide in the drive and didn't have enough left. ST PATRICKS APPEAL chased the pace, bid four wide to loom a threat but came up empty. RELATORRE advanced to the turn, bid five wide to threaten, hung and dropped back. ROYAL GAME sprinted clear to set the pace with a long lead, tired mid stretch and gave way. GLENWICK broke awkwardly, slowly, raced wide early and lacked a bid. BOURBON SHOOTER went seven wide in the drive and failed to respond. EPICURUS failed to threaten in an even effort.
