Footnotes

PERFECT LIGHT raced close to the pace inside, bid off the rail leaving the turn, angled back in past the sixteenth pole, closed along the rail and got up late in an all out effort. FLEET CLASSIC was unhurried early, found her best stride late, was gaining ground and was outfinished while five across at the wire. SHESATOPBALLERINA raced close to the pace between horses, bid four wide, closed steadily and was outfinished in a game effort. GON TO RUN set the pace, responded to pressure but was outfinished in a good try. SOUL DIGGER bumped at the start, pressed the pace, bid willingly to threaten but didn't have enough late. SAVE YOUR STORY was never far off the pace, went seven wide at the top of the lane and lacked the needed rally. MOLLY'S RISK stalked the pace outside, weakened in the drive and dropped back. CARO'S SONG was not a threat.
