BETTER TO BE LUCKY was slow early, went widest in drive, closed with a rush and got up in the final strides. MAGIC NUMBER dropped back at the start, advanced around the turn, closed willingly, assumed command in deep stretch, led briefly and was outfinished in a game effort. JEWEL S. was never far off the pace, closed under steady urging and got up for show. ELLE CEE DEE set a pressured pace, drew clear into the turn, led to deep stretch, faltered and lost position late. SAMURAI JESS saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn, narrowed the gap but didn't have enough late. KATY'S STAR put in a steady effort, failed to rally and did not threaten. RULER OF THE TRIBE pressed the pace, fell back into the turn, continued willingly to stay close to the pace, hung late and lost position. KEY AFFAIR pressed the pace, was through early, fell back and went evenly thereafter. ENTER BACK was not a factor.
