Footnotes

AMERIKITE dropped off the pace at the outset, ranged up to leaders at mid turn, angled out at the top of the lane, split rivals nearing the eighth pole, came determinedly, and was up for the win in the late going. COUNT THEM ALL rated last for a half mile, rallied strongly leaving the turn along the rail, and was gaining on the winner coming to the wire. SAGE HEN stalked close for a half mile, came five wide off the turn, bid for the lead at the eighth pole, but was outfinished from mid track in the last sixteenth. LUSTER LEE dueled for the lead for a half mile, took command at the head of the stretch, looked a winner at the furlong marker, but weakened in the final sixteenth of a mile. SOUNDS OF COURAGE rated evenly throughout, but posed no menace to the top horses in the race. YANKEE VALENTINE established the pace for a half mile, was fully engaged at the top of the lane, faltered at the eighth pole, then retreated tired to the wire. WITCH ON A BROOM was no factor. PAVLOSK loomed near the pace for a half mile, but faded wide leaving the turn.
