A SMILE PER MILE sprinted clear to set the pace, responded to pressure on the turn, drew off and held the advantage under mild left handed urging. GRENDILLA was unhurried early, rallied five wide on the second turn, couldn't gain on the winner and finished second best. MODEL ACTRESS raced in the back, rallied late to be along for show and was best of the rest. PALERMO (MEX) lagged off the rail, offered a mild bid only and failed to menace. MAN'S CANDY was never far off the pace, challenged for the lead four wide on the second turn and gave way. MOTHERS MESSAGE raced within striking distance inside and gave way on the far turn. MARAZDOTZ advanced along the rail to challenge for the lead on the second turn and gave way in the upper stretch. MILLYWAKAY raced close to the pace and gave way on the second turn.
