DRESS BLUES reached the front nearing the half mile pole, saved ground and drew out in upper stretch then was under vigorous hand urging. SICY just off the rail turning for home, raced between rivals nearing the sixteenth pole and earned the place. GLOBAL DEBUTANTE stayed outside and offered a late gain. ARIAT GOLD chased on the turn and weakened in the drive. INDIANA NANA vied for the lead through the early stages, pressed on the turn and tired in the drive. HOLY KUGA broke out some, trailed and lacked a response. FUNKY CHANTEAL stayed on the rail and chased through the lane then tired through the final sixteenth.
