MR. PADRE saved ground and vied early, drew clear on the turn then responded well through the lane and held a rival safe. MINT HUMOR well placed early, bid three wide on the turn and finished willingly while second best. NOTIS SAL advanced between rivals nearing the quarter pole then lacked the needed stretch response. MASTER DEMAND four wide on the turn, was in the five path entering the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CANUCKS ROAR outside into the turn, was six wide entering the stretch and lacked a rally. SHOTGUN WILLY up close early and in the two path into the turn, raced along the rail through the lane and lacked a bid. LOVINTHELIMEIGHT hesitated some at the break to be away, moved up inside, chased turning for home and weakened in the drive. SILVER RATE vied early, chased on the turn and tired through the lane.
