MISSANNALOUISE was unhurried early saving ground, vied into the stretch angling out three wide, was full of run in the stretch and drew out. TRANSCENDING stalked the early leaders three wide, sustained a bid to gain a short lead into the stretch, was challenged in the final furlong then yielded but held the place. CHAI ANN prompted the early pace from the inside and lacked a response going evenly late. ROLLER DERBY GIRL raced mid pack, went five wide and placed a mild bid. JEST A DIVA was void of early speed saving ground and improved her position in the stretch. CONTINENTALMEETING was forced to steady leaving the gate to get away slowly, then saved ground and lacked a rally. PAIR OF EVENTS failed to menace. BISQUIT DOUGH set the early pace racing off the rail, was used up early and stopped.
