SPOKANE DANCER saved ground, assumed command four wide leaving the turn, drew off and extended her lead while being ridden out and finished much the best. LISTA was unhurried early, rallied around the far turn, went seven wide in the drive and got up for place. LA CORAZON lagged in a wide trip, offered a mild bid while eight wide in the drive and was along for show. ALFAWNSOUL settled off the pace, advanced to the turn to get within striking distance, awaited room, bid five wide and hung. ISLE DOITFORYOU chased the pace, moved up to challenge for the lead on the second turn, flattened out and faded. OCEAN BABE raced outside, went six wide in the drive and lacked a rally. LADY KENZIE was not a factor. KEIRA'S WAY was never far back, got through along the rail into the stretch, gave way and fell back. GRANDMA KATE was hustled along, sprinted clear to set the pace to the second turn and was used up.
