MISS TABLE TALK prompted the early issue, raced between foes into the stretch, advanced between rivals late and finished willingly. SPLENDID SUSAN broke a bit slowly, eased out for the drive and finished well. ROSES SURVIVOR raced four deep into the turn, reached the front then weakened in the drive. DOUBLE BUBBLE raced five wide into the lane and loomed a threat then tired. STORMING NORMA (NZ) vied for the early lead between foes and weakened in the drive. WORKING HABIT trailed into the stretch and taken wide, offered a belated gain. CARMA CASTLE well placed to the drive, tired. QUEEN OF CLUBS lacked a rally. SANPETE NATIVE tired through the lane. MARGE'S DREAM GIRL saved ground while vying for the lead and weakened. TIME TO GO NORTH was through early.
