LORD AVALON trailed early, raced along the inside to the lane, eased off the rail inside the furlong marker and reached the leader nearing the sixteenth pole then drew clear. MR. SHADAR saved ground into the turn, raced in the three path entering the lane and earned the place. RAINIER MISSILE moved up along the inside through the opening furlong and vied for the lead, drew clear in the stretch then was not good enough. TRIP THE GENERAL three wide into the turn, raced in the five path entering the stretch and gained some late. DONT MAKE ME MAD vied for the lead and weakened in the drive. WOODEN YA KNOW IT chased to the lane and weakened. BONBONI raced six wide turning for home and lacked a rally.
