TOMMY AND BUSTER vied inside to the second turn, drew off for a clear lead and held well in a driving finish. FORCHTENBERG was unhurried early, bid three wide into the stretch, closed steadily, was gaining ground and earned place. PROUD CAJUN raced in the middle of the pack, rallied six wide into the stretch and finished well. FAR FLUNG was unhurried early, went eight wide at the top of the lane, closed well and gained late. DO WHAT U DARE was void of early speed, shifted out for the drive, offered a mild bid only and failed to menace. BLADE SCUFFLER vied two across to the second turn and flattened out. MR. INSTIGATOR raced mid pack, bid off the rail, got within striking distance and came up empty. TONIGHT AT ELEVEN stalked the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. ROMO TIME was in tight on the first turn, stalked the pace, tired into the second turn and gave way. WILLIE PREVAIL was through early and steadily faded from contention.
