WARREN'S JACK V. stayed close to the pace, awaited room on the turn, angled in at the top of the lane, bid inside, closed willingly to get up late and was all out at the wire. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE was unhurried early and fell far back, bid six wide, closed with a rush, was gaining fast late and just missed. C MY SECRET set the pace with a clear lead and yielded in deep stretch in a game effort. SUPER STEVE bumped at the start, stalked the pace three across, bid but had little left for the drive. GOLDEN MIST stalked the pace inside, had little left and faded through the stretch. LIDGETTIMATE HEAT raced outside, offered a five wide bid, came up empty and dropped back. CONNOR'S BUDDY bumped at the start, stalked the pace between horses, tired on the turn and gave way.
