FANTABULOUS M Q vied inside, swung wide on the turn, fell back, came again and got up late. HANAGAN MEADOW raced close to the pace, bid inside on the turn, assumed command, drew away for a short lead, led to deep stretch and was outclosed. RUNNING RACHIE raced outside, went eight wide in the drive and got up late for show. JUST CHUB raced mid pack, bid inside leaving the turn to loom a threat and hung. PROUD Y BONITA vied two across to the turn, was carried out in tight quarters, fell back and finished evenly. DOUBLE DEE CASH showed good early speed, fell back into the turn and went evenly late. NAT KAT pressed the pace outside, challenged three across on the turn, was carried wide and fell back. SHEBA'S SPIRIT was not a threat. SMOKINBELLE pulled up and was vanned off.
