SWISS ALPINE set the pace inside then responded gamely in the drive and held a rival safe. GULF CAT pressed the issue and held on willingly while needing more. OUACHITA CREEK trailed into the lane then was gaining late from along the rail. LITTLE DUDE lodged a bid inside on the turn, moved out for the drive and lacked the needed late response. MINERO DE ORO four wide into the turn, moved inward and raced just off the rail turning for home and lacked the needed late response. DIAMOND DAN chased three wide and lacked a stretch bid. TANGO MANGO broke out and six wide into the turn, raced in the five path entering the lane and weakened. HEAVY STEVE five wide and between rivals into the turn, raced in the three path into the stretch and lacked a bid.
