Footnotes

MOONLITE ROMANCE broke a bit slowly, saved ground into the turn, raced between rivals passing the quarter pole, moved back to the rail into the lane and reached the front in upper stretch then responded to urging while edging clear. HOT OFF THE BENCH raced three wide into the lane and earned the place. KISS MY CASH raced three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. HOLY ANGELO moved closer three wide on the turn, pressed then weakened late. PIVOT PAD bobbled slightly at the start, prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the turn and weakened in the drive. ACCEPT THE KISS moved in entering the turn, raced in the two path into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. HESO lacked a response. SWEEPINGLY vied for the early lead, saved ground and tired through the lane.
