TRILLY KAT trailed early, moved out for the drive and closed well late while up at the wire. COLONY QUEEN advanced outside on the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and finished gamely. THELIFE OF THE PARTY saved ground and dueled for command, held the advantage passing the eighth pole and yielded grudgingly. CASINO KAY raced four wide and between rivals turning for home and needed more late. START TIME up close early, chased on the turn and needed more. JADIE CAHILL saved ground and lacked the needed late response. SHINE'N TIME dueled for the lead outside a rival and weakened in the drive. LINOVISION stumbled at the start, chased into the turn, weakened then bled.
