DON'T TELL DADDY settled off the early leaders, moved up while four wide on the turn, lodged her bid a furlong out and was up in the final strides. JODY'S INCLUDED was reluctant to load then rated just off the early leader, lodged her bid at mid-stretch, took a short lead late between calls but couldn't hold on. TRUE DECEPTION was four wide on the turn, took a bit of an erratic course through the stretch but finished willingly late. LA COLOMBINA was a bit fractious in the gate before the start, set the pace to mid-stretch then weakened the final sixteenth. MISS DOW JONES was just off the early leaders, loomed a threat nearing the stretch then lacked a further bid. CONDIE'S THE NAME saved ground to no avail. MEET ANZI took the two path on the turn, stayed inside for the drive and tired. NICOLE'S MAGIC was slow into stride after the start then raced a bit green, moved inside into the turn and never threatened. SUSAN'S DELIGHT broke in at the start and trailed throughout.
