POINT ATTENDED raced close to the pace, challenged three across on the turn, inched away and drew off past the eighth pole under urging. RULE BY FORCE raced mid pack outside, went four wide entering the stretch, closed steadily to get up late for place and was no threat to the winner. TWIN SPARKS was away alertly to set the pace to the turn, fell back a bit, continued willingly, didn't have enough late but held for show. BEALE STREET advanced inside, eased out on the turn, bid three wide between horses to get within striking distance and hung late. SPECTACULARTOP stumbled at the start, saved ground and lacked the needed late response. GOIN' DANCIN failed to menace in an even effort. FIVE STAR FORTUNE pressed the pace along the rail to the turn, faltered and dropped back. KIND REGARDS showed speed to the turn, stopped and was not urged late.
