SWISS EXPLOIT was sent to the front, pressed the pace four wide, assumed command into the turn, drew off for a clear lead, shied from left handed urging, drifted out late and just lasted. EL TEJON was steadied at the wire. KATIE'S DAN (NZ) was taken back at the start, was unhurried early, advanced around the turn, closed steadily and was gaining late. FLYING JACK vied between horses, fell back along the backstretch to stalk and faded through the stretch. NONSENSE vied three across, tired into the turn and faded from contention. CLURIOSITY was outrun in a wide trip. BOLD AGREEMENT raced mid pack in an even effort and lacked a bid. DIAMOND TOUCH vied inside to the second turn, tired and gave way.
