BILLY ALLEN (IRE) was in a perfect striking position just off the leaders down the backstretch, lodged a three-deep bid near the quarter pole then drew off the final furlong. GLOBAL TRADER tracked the early leader, vied for the lead on the final bend, remained in contention to mid-stretch then came out some late while clear and was second best. PRORUNNER set the early pace then vied for the lead on the far turn into the stretch and weakened some the final furlong. RUNNING FREE pulled early while trying to be rated in the run to the first turn, saved ground throughout but lacked any stretch bid. CAPITANO was four wide while in contention on the far turn, came five wide for the drive and lacked any bid. WE BROTHERS trailed to the stretch while saving ground on the far turn and lacked a bid. SIEMPRE DISTANTE saved ground around the first turn and never seriously threatened. A claim of foul by the rider of PRORUNNER against the rider of GLOBAL TRADER for alleged interference near the sixteenth pole was not allowed
