LAKOTA GOLD was void of early speed, went six wide in the drive and closed with a rush to get up in the final strides. HIGHLAND HOMBRE raced between horses to the turn, vied throughout and was caught near the wire. WARREN'S BLVD. vied inside throughout and was outfinished in a game effort. WARD BROOKS was never far off the pace, bid inside leaving the turn, eased out for the drive, closed but didn't have enough late. HARRISBURG raced mid pack in a steady effort to narrow the gap but failed to menace. BRAT CAT vied three wide to the turn and weakened. POTATO CHIP MAN was slow early, bid inside and came up empty. THUNDER ALLIANCE broke a bit slowly, had the rider steady in the upper stretch and was outrun. MAD PROSPECTOR stalked the pace while racing off the rail, swung a bit wide and gave way.
