BERRY VALID trailed into the lane, drifted in slightly passing the sixteenth pole then was up late for the place. LINOVISION broke a bit awkwardly to be away a bit slowly, advanced outside on the turn and chased then weakened late. SUMMER SIZZLE moved out turning for home and lacked the needed late response. SHINE'N TIME pressed early, chased on the turn and tired through the lane. HIDDEN HARBOR vied for the early lead, raced just off the inside on the turn and tired.
