TEJANO TROUBLE away slowly, advanced between rivals on the final turn and raced three wide into the lane, reached the front nearing the eighth pole and drew well clear then was geared down nearing the wire. DADDY'S VISION well placed while saving ground, eased off the inside for the drive and finished willingly. MICKEY ROCKS in good position outside, raced four wide turning for home and offered a mild stretch response. FLAMING GLORY prompted the issue, moved to a narrow advantage passing the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. WESTERN ACT raced three wide into the far turn and lacked the needed bid. KATIE'S DAN (NZ) raced off the inside turning for home and lacked a rally. TUG O' WAR set the early pace, saved ground and tired in the drive. CLURIOSITY lacked a response.
