ROLLIN ON DUBS drew clear early, showed the way to the lane and responded to urging while maintaining a safe margin. ENGINEER up close while saving ground, finished willingly while second best. IS IT TUESDAY YET chased and between rivals on the turn, needed more in the drive. DEL MAR DRAMA raced four wide on the turn and chased then lacked the needed stretch response. I'M THE IRISH MAN bumped and in tight at the start, trailed into the lane then was going well at the end. CHELE broke in bumping a rival, chased three wide and was not good enough. THAT TIGER broke a bit slowly and near the rail into the turn, eased out into the lane and lacked the needed response. TWO ONE GUN raced five wide turning for home and lacked a rally. I THINK IT IS raced near the inside on the turn and lacked a bid. MAROZI chased early, saved ground and weakened on the turn.
