SPEEDUBAI vied for the lead for six furlongs, took a clear lead nearing the quarter pole then was ridden out while widening in the drive. MANZERITA moved up along the rail in the run to the far turn, took the three path into the stretch and couldn't threaten the winner while second best. FLY FANNIE FLY hesitated at the start, moved off the rail into the three path down the backstretch, lodged her bid 3-wide at the top of the stretch then weakened. CHEROKEE'S AUTUMN saved ground around both turns, stayed inside for the stretch and lacked a bid. THUNDERHIT moved up along the rail into the far turn, took the three path into the stretch and never threatened. LET'S CUDDLE UP vied for the lead outside the winner to nearing the quarter pole then tired. MAN HUNTER had dropped back and was trailing the field coming into the stretch when unable to avoid a fallen rival in upper stretch and lost the rider. ROLLER DERBY GIRL was four deep while in a contending position down the backstretch, continued four wide into the stretch when she suddenly fell and was vanned off. The stewards posted the inquiry sign regarding the incident at the top of the stretch but no change was made
