BROOKTON vied for the early lead down the backstretch, took a clear advantage in upper stretch, drew well clear then was ridden out. BRIG TACOS was five wide on the turn and into the stretch and was up for the place while not a threat to the winner. KOOL PEACH was in good position into the turn, lodged a three-wide bid at the top of the stretch then was outfinished for the place spot. INFINITE STRIKE was a bit rank while trying to be rated near the five-eighths marker, saved ground on the turn, eased out in upper stretch then lacked the needed late response. ROLLIN STOCK was a bit fractious in the gate before the start then stumbled at the break then was four wide into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. TIZ ONLY FAIR also stumbled at the break, took the three path into the stretch then drifted out badly the final furlong. MARY CELESTE vied for the lead from the rail to near the quarter pole then tired in the drive. OUR VALLEY GIRL broke with the field then was sluggish early, rushed up along the rail to join the leaders into the turn then stopped after a half.
