TONY THE PONY was well placed down the backstretch, found an opening and split rivals a furlong out and quickly drove clear. I'LL TRY rated off the early pace, saved ground to the stretch, raced briefly in traffic in upper stretch, followed the winner and split foes a furlong out and finished well. WE GOT DA FEVA moved into contention while three wide on the far turn, continued three wide and lodged his bid near the quarter pole, vied for the lead a furlong out then couldn't sustain his momentum the final furlong. LIFT MY EYES settled after the start, was five wide into the stretch and gained some ground the final furlong. T J'S DIXIE forced the early pace then vied for the lead to mid stretch and weakened. TYMAKER was five deep down the backstretch, made a four-wide move on the far turn then lacked a further response. ALWAYS ROYAL was unhurried after the start then raced outside horses down the backstretch while six deep, stayed six wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. RENEGADE CIELO set the early pace, responded on the far turn when challenged then tired in the stretch. LOOKN EAST tried to rate around the first turn, saved ground to the stretch then tired. DIAMOND INDY was close up early but was through after a half and tired.
