DOC CAN DANCE stalked inside, angled out on the turn, bid four wide, closed willingly and drew off near the sixteenth pole. SUPERCARLS REMEDY set a pressured pace, was no match late but held for place. SILVER CONTESSA saved ground, advanced inside around the far turn, eased out for the drive, bid five wide and was gaining for second. NO WAY JOSE pressed the pace, bid willingly, came up empty and dropped back. DENAE'S ROMANCE was unhurried early, advanced along the rail on the turn and failed to rally. SAPPHIREDIAMONDS bore out and was checked on the first turn, raced in the back and failed to threaten. LE BRUTE swung wide on the first turn, raced close to the pace and tired into the second turn. TRIPLE NINE was carried wide on the first turn, raced close to the pace, was through after a half and stopped.
