TRIFECTA PHIL up close early three wide, prompted the pace on the turn, reached the front in the stretch and edged clear. A BLACK THORN broke in, moved up inside through the early stages and reached the front, set the pace then was outfinished by the top one. TARAGE raced in the four path entering the lane and offered a late gain. SOLO PERFORMANCE four wide passing the quarter pole, raced five wide turning for home then lacked the needed response. ROAR OF EAGLES raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. CLAIM THE THRONE raced in the three path entering the lane and offered little in the drive. CONDITIONAL vied early, raced between rivals and tired in the drive. DR. POOH bumped at the start, saved ground and lacked a rally.
