DERIVE set the pace and held well in a driving finish. SARATOGA BOOT broke in, raced close to the pace, bid inside on the turn, angled out near the eighth pole, went willingly to the wire, drifted out late and narrowed the gap. ABSOLUTELY COOL was off a step slowly, raced mid pack, went five wide into the stretch, bid, hung but was best of the rest. SPEED BIAS pressed the pace to the turn, leveled off and faded from contention. MISSDEALORNODEAL stumbled at the start, saved ground and offered a mild bid only. RAINIER MISSILE raced outside, went five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. MR. CACHT (ARG) showed speed to the turn and stopped.
