OLD WOODY raced mid pack, closed with a late rush and got up in the final strides. POCO STAMPEDE stalked the pace, went three wide leaving the turn, bid willingly, dueled, had the lead late and was caught. SHOWHOF pressed the pace, bid along the rail to duel for the lead and was outfinished in a game effort. JAZZY IMAGE put in a steady effort in a wide trip but couldn't gain position. BRITE VALENTIN saved ground but lacked a late rally. IN SHOCK set the pace, responded when challenged to duel for the lead past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. PORTLAND broke in, raced in the second flight and lacked a serious bid. DADE PINE was pushed in at the start, failed to rally and was not a menace. RAZ LEA was not a factor. DANCEING DEANO failed to contend.
