RESIDENT AUTHORITY lodged a bid inside on the final turn and earned the place. FOX IN THE HOUSE raced three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. DIAMOND INDY vied briefly for the lead on the clubhouse turn, prompted the issue thereafter and weakened in the drive. SURF ACADEMY raced near the rail and lacked the needed rally. CONSIDER well placed early, raced outside into the lane and lacked a response. The final time was hand timed.
