ARABIAN STORM veered out at the start to be outrun early, raced near the rail into the turn, moved to the three path into the lane, responded to urging then got up late. JUMP ON BOARD showed in front at the break, was steadied into the turn then moved outside, raced three wide turning for home and regained the advantage in upper stretch then yielded late while drifting out. CAPTAIN PARADISE bobbled at the start and outside into the turn, raced in the three path entering the stretch and offered a mild late gain. HIGHDRUM raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. WINSTON BLUE reached the front passing the half mile pole and drew clear on the turn, raced off the rail and weakened in the drive. CEBURUCO raced well placed while saving ground and tired in the drive. I'M ONE KOOL DUDE fractious loading, trailed and lacked a rally.
