Footnotes

LILY'S PRAYER near the rail into the far turn, raced in the three path entering the lane and finished gamely to prevail. ACCOUNTABLE DIVA well placed inside, raced just off the rail turning for home and finished willingly with the rider losing the whip nearing the sixteenth pole. BRITE DYNA set the early pace inside, lost the advantage on the final turn, regained the edge in upper stretch then yielded late. SPENDING TIME lunged out some at the start and trailed, raced five wide into the stretch and was gaining late. TEMPERAZE prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the final turn and weakened in the drive. SEATTLE COUNTDOWN never far back and outside into the far turn, lacked the needed rally. TASTE'S FIRST LADY prompted early three wide, moved in on the final turn and lacked the needed stretch response.
