SKY CHIEF raced mid pack, rallied around the turn, went six wide at the top of the stretch, closed well, drew clear near the sixteenth pole and held off the late charge of SHYROCK. SHRYOCK was unhurried early, advanced through traffic around the turn, angled out near the eighth pole for racing room, closed fast once clear and was gaining ground. ROGUE RIVER broke out, stalked the pace, bid to get within striking distance and hung. PRARIE FALCON was away well to vie inside, drew clear at the top of the lane, was outclosed and dropped back. SLEWEY ARMSTRONG raced mid pack in an even effort. WESTERN COMMENT stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, weakened and faded from contention. QUICK MEETING was not a threat. CLIFF DWELLER was unhurried early, saved ground, went seven wide at the top of the lane and lacked a rally. HE'S A FLYER vied to the second turn, tired and gave way. MATUCO (ARG) vied outside, tired into the second turn and gave way.
