### Footnotes

ECKSTEIN advanced into the turn and reached the front on the bend, dueled outside a rival and proved best to the wire. IMA POET sprinted well clear early, saved ground and was rated into the turn, battled inside the top one and finished willingly. SHOW ME HOME chased on the turn, raced just off the inside into the lane and remained clear of the rest. SKY CHIEF lodged a bid outside on the turn, raced four wide into the stretch and weakened in the drive then was vanned off. OKIE DOKIE PETEY came in at the start, moved inside turning for home and lacked a rally. VYING FOR VICTORY chased and tired through the lane. GET YOUR SHINEBOX forced in some at the start, raced off the inside and lacked a rally. PROUD CAJUN moved off the inside on the turn and lacked a bid. FOR DADDY in tight leaving the gate, showed little thereafter. MER FLOWER (ARG) was outrun.
