STRIKING OFFER was reluctant to load, moved up along the backstretch to vie two across, inched clear near the sixteenth pole and proved best. GABE'S GOLD raced close to the pace inside, angled out on the turn, bid five wide, closed steadily and got up for place. BRAZILLIANO set the pace around the first turn, vied inside, yielded near the sixteenth pole and lost position. LOUIE SUNRISE was slow early, advanced inside around the far turn, got through along the rail and closed well under steady urging. BUCKS ARROW raced in the middle of the pack, swung wide leaving the turn, tired and gave way. CALL ME MICK was outrun in an even effort. COUNTRYBOYSROLL was not a factor. CAGEY FINALE stalked the pace while racing between horses, was through after a half and stopped. J V M BOY stalked outside, was through after a half and stopped.
