WANTA BE GOOD raced along the rail through the lane and finished well while drawing clear late. HENRY D. set the pace then was no match late to the top one while holding the place. MADURO prompted the early issue, was asked on the final turn and was not good enough. U S S OKLAHOMA bothered some early, raced outside entering the lane and was gaining late. POTENTIAL RIVAL never far back, lacked the needed late response. KING KAMEHAMEHA lunged out some at the start then in a bit close, lacked the needed bid. IFONLYWEBELIEVE wide early, raced well placed outside and tired through the lane. JR HILLS lacked a response. THE HUNTED ONE saved ground entering the far turn and lacked a response then weakened. EL MARDRAZO well placed early, weakened on the final turn.
