ANNIE'S BOU PEEP was never far off the pace, rallied three wide leaving the turn and got up in the final strides in a long drive. TRAVEL THE SUN got away well to press two wide to the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. MADAM CUPCAKE raced in the second flight, rallied late under steady left handed urging and got up at the wire for show. EARTH TO HEAVEN set a pressured pace inside, dueled to the final strides and yielded grudgingly. ALL NIGHT LONG (IRE) raced in the back, lacked a rally and failed to menace. PALERMO (MEX) showed early speed while saving ground and offered no closing response. ALL IS ROSEY trailed the field.
