

STARTAC was unhurried early, launched his bid after a half, assumed command four wide leaving the turn, drew off and was ridden out. GOLDEN TANGLE stalked the pace off the rail, challenged for the lead on the second turn but was no match for the winner. LEARING AT KATHY raced mid pack, rallied into the far turn to loom a threat, couldn't challenge the top two but held position. ANOTHER GEAR raced mid pack, rallied into the far turn, got in tight quarters at the top of the stretch, went five wide but came up empty. BULLY'S NORTH raced close to the pace while saving ground but had little left for drive. TOP HIT raced within striking distance but had nothing left for drive. DOUBLE TIME set the pace to the second turn and gave way. POLISHED ACT stumbled at the start, raced in the back and lacked a rally. IRONMAN DEHERE held a good position to the far turn and tired. PROHIBITIVE lacked a bid and failed to threaten. RESOLVE was eased.
