ACOLYTE bided his time early, saved ground on the far turn, stayed inside for the drive and lodged his bid nearing the furlong grounds then was edging clear late. CONDITIONAL was rated on the lead, responded when asked in the stretch but couldn't contain the winner in a good try. REAGAN'S GENIUS broke a bit awkward then was a bit rank while fighting rating in to the first turn, stayed in contention to deep stretch then weakened slightly. INODINO forced the early issue while between foes, stayed in contention to the drive then lacked a solid late bid. SIMPLY SINNING moved up outside foes into the far turn then split horses inside the quarter pole, was five wide into the stretch but didn't have enough late. BOLD AGREEMENT rated off the leader after the start, took the two path into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. TOUCH MY ABS was three deep while forcing the pace down the backstretch then weakened in the drive. CITY VENTURE was rank leaving the chute and again into the first turn while fighting rating, was five wide on the far turn and tired.
