FANTASYVILLE dueled between horses, inched away leaving the turn, drifted out in the drive and drew off past the eighth pole. B L'S SASSY was fractious in the parade, moved up four across to threaten, was no match late and finished second best. PERHAPS PERHAPS broke sharply, dueled three across to the turn, was unable to sustain her bid but held for show. PINE GROVE was void of early speed, found her best stride late and gained position. BEAUDACIOUS LADY saved ground, bid inside to get within striking distance and hung in the lane. MONDAY MYSTERY dueled inside, was checked entering the turn, fell back, angled out, went six wide in the drive and failed to gain. DANCE CRUISE was outrun in a wide trip. CLASSIC GAIT broke out and was steadied briefly at the start, trailed the field and failed to contend.
