COTTON BELLE was sent to the front to set the pace and held safely while being kept to task. SAVE YOUR STORY chased the pace, couldn't gain ground and was no match for the winner. WILDAKCELERATION lagged while saving ground, bid inside on the turn and was along for show while no threat to the top two. CARO'S SONG was crowded at the start, dropped inside along the backstretch, advanced to the turn to get within striking distance, had nothing left for the drive and faded through the stretch. COALESCE was void of early speed, swung wide leaving the turn and failed to threaten. MYSTERY CHANNEL showed little in a wide trip. CEE'S HOLLIE broke out, raced close to the pace outside, was through early and gave way.
