PEACH FESTIVAL stalked the pace inside, angled out on the turn, closed under steady urging and got up near the sixteenth pole. HIDDEN RIVER broke out, awkwardly, stalked the pace between horses, angled out on the turn, challenged for the lead, dueled, got a head in front briefly past the eighth pole, was outfinished and all out for place. MARYSAYSZIPIT broke in, was never far off the pace, swung wide leaving the turn, closed steadily and was gaining late for second. TY N JEWEL ducked in sharply at the start, veered out sharply to be very wide early and closed well inside while racing greenly. VALLEY EMPRESS lagged while saving ground, swung wide one the turn and continued in a steady effort to narrow the gap. EXTRA COIN was crowded at the start, hustled along to set the pace, responded when challenged to duel for the lead and faltered past the eighth pole. RUGGER RED broke out, stalked outside, swung wide on the turn and gave way.
