AZA set a pressured pace, drew off on the second turn for a clear lead and held well in a driving finish. GRANDPA ROY was a bit rank at the start, raced in the back, rallied five wide entering the stretch and closed to narrow the gap. MEDICINE CREEK was unhurried early to fall far back, went six wide in the drive and finished well. BENSON in the back, awaited room on the far turn and upper stretch, eased out and closed once clear. KINGSVILLE settled off pace, awaited room on the turn and in the upper stretch and lacked the needed late rally. OUTRAGEOUS LIMIT vied between horses to the second turn, fell back and finished evenly. HIS WAY vied three wide between horses, fell back into the second turn and flattened out. TRIFECTA PHIL went five wide on the first turn, pressed the pace four across, was through after a half and dropped back steadily.
