VALARI lodged a bid four wide bid on the turn, battled for the lead through the lane and drew clear late. STRAWBERRY SUN FUN saved ground and vied for the lead then was no match late to the top one while second best. POSS'S RECRUIT up close and three wide on the turn, lacked a solid late response while earning the show. TOPLESS broke alertly, vied for the lead and weakened in the drive. REAL AWSOME JET raced five wide into the lane and lacked the needed rally. ANGULAR MOMENTUM in tight briefly on the backstretch, moved out on the turn and lacked a stretch bid. MISS HONEY MOON broke a bit awkwardly, saved ground and lacked a rally. KINDA CUTE moved to the rail on the backstretch, saved ground and lacked a bid. C T'S SUNSHINE GAL was in tight on the backstretch and stumbled nearly unseating the rider. FRIEND IN PARIS came in leaving the gate, drifted in some on the backstretch and tired through the lane. LILBITAGO bumped leaving the gate and in a bit close on the backstretch, weakened on the turn. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the run down the backstretch but no change was made.
