JUST JEBICAH set the pace inside, widened into midstretch then maintained a safe margin. TRIP THE GENERAL advanced four wide on the turn and finished willingly while second best. KWIK up close along the inside into the turn, stayed on the rail and raced in a bit tight briefly passing the sixteenth pole then gained some late. EMPIRE HOUSE stumbled at the start, raced three wide and between rivals turning for home and weakened in the drive. MALTESE TIGER tracked into the turn, raced just off the inside and lacked the needed response. LAHCOTAH lacked a rally.
